At the end of the First Age most of Beleriand is destroyed after the War of Wrath when the host of Valinor defeats Morgoth/Melkor.

Morgoth is cast into the Void but his servant Sauron escapes.

Most of the Elves leave Middle-Earth and go to Valinor. Some Elves choose to stay: Galadriel, Celeborn, Elrond, Celebrimbor and Gil-galad.

The power and wealth of Khazad-dûm is increased by the Dwarves from Ered Lûin (Blue Mountains, the ruined cities of Nogrod and Belegost)

Realms and Events: LINDON (Gil-galad, High King of the Noldor); RIVENDELL (The Last Homely House, Elrond, Lord of Rivendell); EREBRIAN (Celebrimbor, Lord of Eregion); ERERON (The Doors of Durin are constructed by Celebrimbor and Narvi; The gates of Moria are shut); ERERON (The power and wealth of Khazad-dûm is increased by the Dwarves from Ered Lûin); ERERON (Annatar becomes friend with the elves of Eregion; The forging of the Nine and Seven rings; The forging of the Three rings); ERERON (Eregion destroyed by Sauron); ERERON (Durin III, King of Khazad-dûm); ERERON (The power and wealth of Khazad-dûm is increased by the Dwarves from Ered Lûin).

REALM OF THE SILVAIN ELVES: LÓRIEN / LÓRINAND / LOTHLÓRIEN, WOODLAND REALM

Realms and Events: LÓRIEN (Amdir, King of Lórien; Realm of the Silvain Elves of Greenwood of the Great/Mirkwood); WOODLAND REALM (Oropher, King of the Woodland Realm); ERERON (Sauron settles in Mordor and begins to build Barad-dûr, the Dark Tower, completed after 600 years); ERERON (S.A. 1600 Sauron creates the One ring in the fires of Mount Doom); ERERON (S.A. 2351 The first appearance of the Nazgûls, the Ring-Wraiths).

REALM OF THE DUNEDAIN: MORDOR, GONDOR

Realms and Events: MORDOR (Sauron is defeated; Shadow over Númenor); GONDOR (The foundation of Minas Anor/Tirith, Osgiliath and Minas Ithil (T.A. 2002) Morgul; The Southern Kingdom of the Dúnedain; Amroth, King of Lórien; Thranduil, King of the Woodland Realm; Gondor (3320-3441 Anirion, King of Gondor; 3320-T.A. 2 Isildur, King of Gondor); The Downfall of Númenor (3319).

Realms and Events: NÚMENOR (Tar-Súrion, King 1304-1366; Tar-Telperiën, Queen 1366-1731; Tar-Minastir, King 1731-1869; Ar-Adûnakhôr, King 2899-2942; Tar-Palantir, King 3177-3255; Ar-Pharazôn, King 3255-3319).
